### BARC Field Day Plan (06/24-25)

BARC's 2017 Field Day Exercise will be held at Sackett Wright Park again this year on Saturday & Sunday June 24-25.

As in past years, a *BARC Newsletter—Special 2017 Field Day Edition* will be sent out the Sunday before FD with a detailed overview of all Field Day related information and activities. In the meantime, here is the current **basic schedule of activities:**

#### Saturday 24 June

**0730-0800** Antenna Crew, Power Crew and Site Prep Crew will report directly to the Park to begin installations and preliminary set-up.

**0800** All other members will report to the Clubhouse to load up BARC Field Day equipment, supplies, support gear, tables, chairs, etc. for transport to the Park between 0915 and 0930.

**0930** Breakfast provided by Russ Roysden and Tudor's Biscuit World of Xenia. Coffee provided by BARC prepared by Elizabeth King. Soft drinks and bottled water provided by BARC and available all during Field Day event.

**~1000** Set-up of all Field Day equipment, tables, chairs, networked logging system, signage, etc., continues

**~ Noon – 1300** Lunch (**hamburgers & hot dogs & assorted condiments**) for set-up crew provided by BARC and prepared by BARC Hospitality Coordinator Tink Siwecki and her sidekick, Steve.

**~1230** Set-up continues

**1400** 24-hr Field Day On-Air Operational Period Begins

**1730** BARC Annual Field Day Family Picnic. BARC provides Broasted Chicken from Dot's Market and BARC members bring a side dish to share (veggie, salad, dessert, casserole, etc.)

**~1830** Field Day on-air operations continue in the Shelter as the picnic/socializing continues in the picnic tables area under the canopies.

#### Sunday 26 June

**Midnight Snacks, Breakfast & Lunch** Nothing formal—Bring your own or partake of leftover chicken (kept on ice) and other picnic goodies as desired.

**1400** 24-hr Field Day On-Air Operational Period Ends and “Tear Down” begins—**DO NOT TURN OFF POWER TO ANY LOGGING COMPUTERS**

**~1400-1600 (or until done)**

- Take down antennas and towers and load onto trailer. Transport tower sections back to storage area and off-load.
- Pack up all equipment and supplies
- Load up all equipment, supplies, tables, chair and other Field Day items (coax, power cables, signage & banners, etc.)
- Transport everything back to Clubhouse and off-load
- Secure Shelter and surrounding area—make sure trash is picked up—leave site better than we found it!
