"Basic bare bones agenda would be:

"Getting radios and computers to "play together" - interfacing, levels, cables and all the "basics"

"Standard software in use today (FLdigi, FLARQ/FLAMP, WSJTX, QSSTV, GQRX, Direwolf etc) Introduction to modes and uses - EMCOMM and beyond HANDS ON!! Think this is the most important

"Can use the club equipment - IC7300 - or bring your own. Would bring own laptop for use at home as desired. HT interfaces will be covered from 9 pin DIN to the basic 3.5/2.5mm inputs.

"If would like, can explore different OS configurations, high speed HF ops, node gateways operations, and small computer operations like with a Arduino or Raspberry platform.

"Outside the scope, can work with weak signal folks and those interested in the small magnetic antennas as well.

"If there is any specific interest, please let me know. Would like to try and get a show of hands/email replies by the chili dinner so that we can start to get the classes in order."

BARC 2018 Dues Now Payable

BARC Treasurer Paul Sharp KD8OPN has announced that he now is accepting dues for 2018.

Most BARC memberships expire December 31, 2017. Free memberships for hams newly licensed in 2017 expire 12 months from the end of the month first licensed. Free memberships for new hams licensed in November or December 2017 are good through December 31, 2018. New members joining BARC in November or December 2017 pay \$15 which includes 2018 dues.

- Annual membership renewal is \$15 per member and \$3 for each additional family member living at the same address.
- BARC members first licensed in 2017 who elected free membership will be notified by the Treasurer of their free membership expiration date. Such members will pay a pro-rated amount of dues for the 2018 membership year.
- 2017 memberships become delinquent if not renewed by the February 2018 meeting. The 2018 Membership Directory will include all members who have renewed or joined by 1 March 2018.

Dues help support Club activities such as the Clubhouse, the Communications Center, Field Day

expenses, the Repeaters, and other purchases and activities as approved by the Club during the year.
