FCC TV SPECTRUM REPACK PROGRAM

Fred will present an overview of the FCC Broadcast Television Spectrum

Repack Program currently in progress. The results of this nationwide program

will vacate current television broadcast channels 38 – 51 for future

occupancy by broadband data and video programming providers.

on Channels 14 – 36 will be reassigned to a new channel.

(Did you know that <u>Ch-37</u> never was a TV broadcast channel?)

Thus, all current television stations in our local Dayton-Cincinnati market, except for one, will be <u>"repacked"</u> into the remaining television broadcast spectrum between Channels 2 - 36.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:30 by the President.

BARC Community Marquee Signs. Fred Stone has yet to hear back from sign maker, but he has sent another e-mail.

Clubhouse EmComm Generator. No action since last planning meeting.

Electronic Service Bench. The first "BARC Tech Night" will be held Thursday July 12 at 7:00 PM (vs 7:30). Tim Procuniar N8NQH will discuss CTCSS.

Field Day 2018. Chairman Ray Hitt N8VMX was unable to attend this evening due to illness. Ray reports in absentia:

"I have gathered up all the data from Field Day. Logs, formal message traffic, the ARRL bulletin, the logs of visitors, and so on. I submitted this data over last weekend to ARRL via their web page, with a follow-up e-mail of required proof items. I will put a briefing together for the August Club meeting. I would like to thank everyone involved -- it ran very smooth, and that was largely due to everyone's attention to detail, experience, and maintaining a great attitude. Thanks!"

Ray also reported that that between 4am-11am Sunday, his FT-897 radio took a surge while he was absent. He examined the radio using BARC's tech bench. As best he could tell, there are either Zener diodes, MOSFETs, or transistors that are sacrificial during a surge. Yaesu charges \$70 per hour plus parts, thus it may be an expensive repair. Ray is asking the Committee to consider helping to defray the cost of this repair; mainly because he was not present when the surge happened, and he cannot be sure that all the proper procedures were followed to prevent such a surge. The planning group asks Ray to provide some additional details on the likely costs.

State of Ohio Charitable Organization Filings. Russ Roysden reports all necessary filings have been submitted.

EmComm. Roger Parrett lead a discussion on integrating DMR in BARC's EmComm program to better align as a resource for the Bellbrook, Sugarcreek, and Greene County community.

Meeting Programs. Coordinator Jim Totten reports that he is struggling to find a presenter for the July General Membership meeting. The rest of the year is OK.

Repeaters. Russ Roysden reports:

- Noise. Ray Hitt has volunteered to troubleshoot. He also will check the cables between the duplexer and the radio.
- <u>6m Repeater.</u> Russ has the working transmitter and receiver, but a duplexer is still needed.
- <u>Hardline</u>. Hardline is at Chris Stauter's house. We are awaiting availability of the repeater site owner to install the hardline. Russ will contact the site owner to inquire. Fred indicated that the MESH antennas may need to be changed out also.

Education. The Antenna Study Group has concluded for the season.

BARC Website. Co-Coordinator Bob French reports that an "Events" tab has been added to the website. Also, the new member registration form needs to be updated on the website.

Clubhouse Air Conditioners. The planning group has agreed to purchase two new higher capacity air conditioners to replace the aging and/or failing units. Paul will purchase two 12 to 15 BTU/hr units. A team will have to be assembled to install the units.
