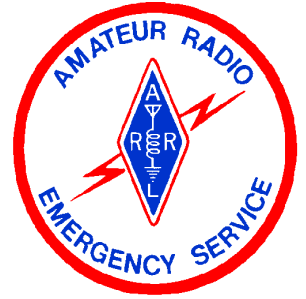

## BARC 2017 Dues Now Payable

Most BARC memberships expire December 31, 2016. Free memberships for hams newly licensed in 2016 expire 12 months from the end of the month first licensed. Free memberships for new hams licensed in November or December are good through December 31, 2017. New members joining in November or December pay \$15 for 2017 dues.

- Annual membership renewal is \$15 per member and \$3 for each additional family member living at the same address.
- BARC members first licensed in 2016 will be notified by the Treasurer of their free membership expiration date. Such members will pay a prorated amount of dues for the 2017 membership year.
- 2016 memberships become delinquent if not renewed by the February meeting. The 2017 Membership Directory will include all members who have renewed or joined by March 1, 2017.

Dues help support Club activities such as the Clubhouse, the Communications Center, Field Day expenses, the Repeaters, and other purchases and activities as decided by the Club during the year.

## ARRL 2016 National Parks on the Air

As the National Park Service (NPS) celebrates its 100th anniversary this year, radio amateurs will help mark the occasion with the ARRL National Parks on the Air (NPOTA) event [began January 1<sup>st</sup> 2016].

NPOTA will run throughout the year with activity promoted and encouraged from each of the more than 430 official NPS administrative units and affiliated areas across the US. This includes all 59 National Parks as well as National Battlefields, Historic Sites, Memorials, Preserves, Reserves, Rivers, Seashores, National Scenic Trails, and other units.

The program will have two participation tracks — Chasers and Activators. Chasers will simply attempt to make contact with operators in as many of the NPS units as possible. Activators will attempt to activate as many of the units as possible. NPOTA participants may serve in both roles. Chaser and Activator totals will be tracked via an online “Leader Board” based on LoTW data, just as was done during the ARRL Centennial QSO Party. **The Meeting was called to order at 7:39 by the President.**

### **Rotor Installation Review – Jim Tideman N8IDS**

Jim described his modification of 2 of 3 station rotors with pigtailed for quick disconnects. This will allow connection of the rotors to alternate controllers at multiple stations. Jim proceeded to describe the connection plan in detail.

### **Repeater Site Topics and UDRC (Universal Digital Radio Controller).**

The repeater site owner has been working out of town but will be returning this weekend. He will be contacting Fred Stone to set up a meeting on a variety of topics.

- Internet access is available at the repeater site for UDRC, Echolink, IRLP, etc.
- Generator; Chris to re-jet for alternate fuel
- New transmission lines (hard line); Ken Moak has a source to purchase surplus hard line.
- Mesh Antenna and Winlink Gateway. Fred Stone, Eric Vinande, Russ Roysden N8NPT and Bill Curtice will likely be the meeting attendees.

Additional comments (Eric Vinande): Cannot have both UDRC and IRLP/Echolink on a given repeater. UDRC can be on one repeater (2m or 440) and IRLP/Echolink on the other. Eric will give a talk on IRLP/Echolink at the November meeting to gauge interest.

**CQWW SSB.** Eric Vinande reports the following contest statistics: 84 Contacts, 80000 Points and 6 participants. Eric is willing to continue coordination of contests at BARC.

**Excess Antennas in Coal Bin.** Pieces and parts of antennas are not useable by the club and will be sold.

**Surplus Donated Radios.** No response from either a local security company or Beaver Creek CERT (Ken Cornett) concerning acquisition of these radios. There is no further interest by ARES. Per Ken Gunton and Ken Moak these will simply be sold or disposed of in short order.

**Google Drive for BARC File Sharing.** In process – see September notes.

**Nomination's Committee:** An e-mail request has been sent out to the club requesting nominations for the Jr. Director seat and club officers. A Junior Director nominee will be needed. The current Jr.

Director moves to Sr. Director. All incumbent officers have agreed to run for an additional term. Additional nominations may be made up until the November General Membership meeting.

**Clubhouse Lockbox.** The outside lockbox was found opened with the combination entered. The keys were left in the clubhouse. The membership needs to be reminded of the proper protocol for clubhouse access and security.

**Installation of ceiling speakers for the Clubhouse.** These will be installed by the November General Membership meeting. Several members have agreed to meet on Wednesday November 9<sup>th</sup> at 10AM to work on the project.

The **BARC Lunch Distribution List** has been updated and this agenda item may be removed for future meetings.

**Donated Audio Equipment and Speakers.** Steve Siwecki will be evaluating the equipment for potential BARC Movie Night surround sound use. He will report on the status at the February Planning Group after the next Movie Night (January).

**BARC Financial Report.** Treasurer Paul Sharp reported the current to-date financial summary.

Pending Expenses: PO Box fee; \$100 gift certificate for repeater site owner; ARRL equipment insurance.

Pending Income: 2017 Member Dues (currently payable); Lion's Club donation; \$100 donation from a member for the antenna project.

Paul requests that the BARC radio equipment insurance list be reviewed for replacement value, and criteria for insuring. Ken Moak will work with Paul on the equipment insurance issue.

**Monthly Meeting Program Topics.** Per Ken Moak, Eric Vinande is to present an informational review of IRLP/Echolink at the November General Membership meeting. Ken Moak, the current program coordinator, has plenty of topics for available months. He will inform Fred in ample time for inclusion in the monthly newsletter.

- Planning a training program for the IC-7300.
- Antennas installation is imminent.

- Two perpendicular wire antennas for 80- 60- & 40-meter wires ready to be ordered.
- New 160-m inverted-L to be installed.
- Ready to assemble Yagi antenna on hand for 12/17m and 2m/440mHz.
- Evaluation of tower/mast grounding is pending.
- Plenty of JT2015 cable available for 6m/HF.
- Suggest 7/8 hardline for VHF/UHF.

**Station Logging.** Karen Moak reported that paper logbooks will be used for casual operating; i.e. handwritten logging (legibly please). Electronic logging programs will continue to be used for contesting; however, member training will be required.
