[BARC 2017 Dues Are Due](#)

Most BARC memberships expire December 31, 2016. Free memberships for hams newly licensed in 2016 expire 12 months from the end of the month first licensed. Free memberships for new hams licensed in November or December are good through December 31, 2017.

- Annual membership renewal is \$15 per member and \$3 for each additional family member living at the same address.
- BARC members first licensed in 2016 will be notified by the Treasurer of their free membership

expiration date. Such members will pay a prorated amount of dues for the 2017 membership year.

- 2016 memberships become delinquent if not renewed by the February meeting. The 2017 Membership Directory will include all members who have renewed or joined by March 1, 2017.

Dues help support Club activities such as the Clubhouse, the Communications Center, Field Day expenses, the Repeaters, and other purchases and activities as decided by the Club during the year.

The Meeting was called to order at 7:33 by the President.

Meeting with Repeater Site Owner. Russ Roysden N8NPT reports, in absentia, that the meeting was productive. Internet connectivity is available at the site for BARC to access. There is no apparent issue with tower climbing and running additional hardline. The site owner will contact Russ directly about both issues (including hardline cost).

Chris Stauter added that installation of MESH antennas at the site should be no problem. Additional buildings will be constructed at the site and BARC may be granted access to them. Chris will help to convert an existing back-up generator from natural gas to propane (or vice versa). Chris will likely assist the site owner with tower climbing and hardline installation.

440-MHz Repeater Firmware Upgrade. Russ Roysden reports, in absentia, that if there is consensus that the 2-m repeater unit is stable, he will remove the 440 MHz repeater and send it in for the firmware upgrade.

BARC 2016 Financial Audit. Jim Totten phoned into the meeting to report that an Audit Committee has been formed consisting of himself, Henry Ruminski W8HJR, and Jerry Miller WD8QAI.

BARC T-Shirt Order. Karen Moak KM8Q reports, in absentia, that there are nine orders for eleven T-shirts. She will give the details to Paul Sharp for placing the orders. Two of the orders have been prepaid.

Paper and Electronic Logging. Karen Moak will be making a trip to the clubhouse to validate the last of the QSL cards received to date. She had intended to finish the project tonight.

Greene County Amateur License Courses. Classes will start in February.

BARC EchoLink/IRLP. Eric Vinande KG6NFJ reports, in absentia, that the Raspberry Pi-based EchoLink/IRLP hardware has been received. Internet connectivity at the repeater site is expected to be established no later than January 30th. At that time the hardware will be tested and connected to the 2m repeater. Henry Bussey reports that Tim

Proconiar N8NQH has volunteered to help with the Echolink/IRLP installation and set-up.

ARRL Field Day 2017. The Sackett-Wright Park location has been reserved for 24-25 June 2017.

BARC Financial Report. Treasurer Paul Sharp reports the current period to date financial summary and that he continues to collect dues for 2017 and expects to deposit the Lion's Club donation soon.

Club Equipment Insurance. Ken Moak and Paul Sharp will update the insured equipment list by removing items sold, adding newly purchased equipment, and verifying replacement values.

Communication Center Update. Ken Moak reports, in absentia, that detailed information can be found in his latest station upgrade status email. In addition, he, Paul Sharp, and Karen Moak worked on the 80/60/40 dipole antennas. They will perform its final tuning at the clubhouse during installation. Paul's similar dipole "looked good right out of the gate"!

General Membership Meeting Programs. Ken Moak sent out a list of presentations to club members. He is already receiving offers from member for new presentations.

Excess Club Equipment Sale. An updated email was sent to the Club today; already one Drake W-4 and the TS-570 have been sold.

Roof Access. The contractor has removed the window and it will soon be replaced with a "short door". Also, the center post on the gymnasium door will be removed for easier movement of large items in and out of the building.
